## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Each team can consist of up to 10 players and 2 managers,
- Teams and family members must use entrance gates 9 & 10 – entry will be free of charge to the stadium.
- Parking on the day is available free of charge – there are a limited number of spaces available in both the main car park and Hazelbury Crescent Car park.
- Only managers and squads are allowed to enter the field of play.
- Each game will last 8mins straight. Normal football association match-day game rules apply, except goalkeepers can-not kick the ball out of their hands over goal height. (NO half time)
- For Free kick / Kick-ins opposing players must be at least 2 metres away from the ball.
- **Referee's decision is final.**
- Each team can make as many substitutions as they wish. Substitutes must be on the side of the pitch with the managers. (NOT wandering around the stadium)
- NO footballs to be brought into the stadium, only match day footballs are allowed.
- There will be **no room on the pitch for warm ups**, teams playing the next game will get a small amount of time before there match begins
- NO alcohol to be brought into the stadium, food and drink (not alcoholic) can be purchased from the kiosks that are open on the day.
- Please ensure that your team put their rubbish in the bins provided, each team will be given their own black bag for their rubbish.
- Each team member playing will receive a medal.
- Fixtures and timetables will be given out on the day.
- In all instances the referee's decision will be final.
