How to find the site:



We will put a sign up that says Dunstable District Beaverie that we will put out opposite the entrance. Please be aware that the entrance is single file and will be controlled by marshals when the parents arrive.

**Arrival** – Please can a leader from each group wait at the edge of the car park to gather their Beavers. Please let Buffalo know when all your group are here or if any are missing.

After the bases finish at 14:30 we will do a group activity which we would be grateful if all adults could assist with where possible. The event will close with a campfire. At the end of the day Beavers may be collected from the edge of the car park where they were dropped off in the morning.

**Groups** – At the briefing each group will be given an envelope containing wrist bands. On each band there will be a group number which will indicate the group your Beaver is in for

the day. Please ensure that the wrist bands are round each Beavers left wrist. All groups will contain at least 2 Beavers from your colony so if you want two Beavers together please make sure you give them the same group no. **If there is any other information other leaders may need to know such as allergies/ medical conditions please note these on the wrist band.**

Each adult will be assigned a group for the day to look after. Groups will consist of 7/8 Beavers

**Bases** – The start and end of each base will be indicated by a whistle. Bases should last for 25 minutes to allow 5 minutes for the groups to move round, grab a drink, go for a wee, etc. *Please ensure that all bases are ready to go by 10.30.*

**Drinks** – These will be available from the purple shelters throughout the day. If you send a Beaver to get a drink during a base please ensure that an adult knows where they are.

**Cold drinks** – available for all – please make sure your Beaver takes their plastic bottle with them to put the drink in.

**Hot Drinks** – We will have an urn on for **ADULT use only.** *Please bring a suitable cup for use.*

*Drinking water is available from a tap on the outside of the toilet block.*

**Please be aware that water taps are a short distance away near the toilet block**

**Biscuits** – Will be available throughout the day

**Lunch** – Each Beaver/ Leader to bring their own.

**Shelter** – We're hoping for nice weather but please bring a shelter/ gazebo if you have one for shade/ cover. Please ensure that Beavers are encouraged to apply sun cream as appropriate.



**First Aid** – Please bring a first aid kit with you to ensure that first aid can be promptly provided at the base you are running.



**Lake** – There is a lake near the area we are using. Tape will be placed across some areas where **Beavers will not be permitted.** Beavers should be supervised and there is no reason for them to be near the edge of the lake at any point during the day.

**In Touch** – Please ensure that you have appropriate in touch in place.
